CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE TEMPORARY IMPORT OF VEHICLE INTO MALAWI

The legislation covering the importation of vehicles into Malawi has special provision covering the temporary importation of vehicles under certain conditions. If you are visiting Malawi for a short period, either on business or pleasure, you may be entitled to import your vehicle temporarily without payment of taxes, at the discretion of the Commissioner General. If you wish to avail yourself of this provision you must make a declaration to an official of the MRA at your place of entry into Malawi.

To qualify for temporary import status, you must undertake to adhere to the following conditions stipulated by the Commissioner General of the MRA in accordance with the legislation of Malawi.

NOTE: Failure to adhere to the conditions will render the vehicle liable to seizure and the importer liable to prosecution.

- The vehicle must be properly declared on importation.
- The importer must be a bona fide visitor to Malawi and NOT resident in Malawi.
- The importer must be able to show ownership of the vehicle or have the written permission of the owner of the vehicle.
- Whilst in Malawi, the vehicle must not be sold, hired, leased, loaned or otherwise disposed of; neither must it be driven by nay Malawian resident.
- The vehicle must be covered by valid third party insurance for the entire period of its stay in Malawi.
- The vehicle must be re-exported on or before the date shown on the Temporary Import Permit (TIP) issued by the MRA, or on the departure of the importer, whichever is sooner.
- The TIP must be surrendered to an official of the MRA on departure from Malawi.
- In the case of accident, the importer must report the facts immediately to an official of the MRA. Once satisfied as to the circumstances the Commissioner General may grant an extension to the original period.

WARNING: FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THESE CONDITIONS RENDERS THE VEHICLE LIABLE TO SEIZURE AND THE IMPORTER LIABLE TO PROSECUTION

These provisions relate only to those entering Malawi for a short term. Other provisions exist for the permanent importation of vehicles and for vehicles being imported by people moving to Malawi permanently.
